Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to full time TCDSB students
- Eligible applicants must commit to participating in the YSP virtually for the entire week of chosen program
- Must currently be in grade 10, 11 or 12
- Demonstrated financial need
- Eligible applicants must have demonstrated academic excellence.

Disclaimer: If the scholarship applicant has registered for a YSP module already the applicant will no longer be eligible for the YSP scholarship.
