Every summer, high school students are offered a unique law school experience by the University of Toronto's Faculty of Law. During the Law YSP, students currently enrolled in grades 10 through 12 can spend between one and four weeks at the Faculty of Law discussing advanced legal concepts, learning about the reality of the Canadian legal system, and applying their knowledge in a variety of stimulating environments. For the summer of 2022 the program will be delivered in-person at the University of Toronto Faculty of Law. Scholarships are offered on the merit of each student's application and demonstrated financial need. A All scholarships cover the full cost of the program for one of the six modules.

- Open to full time TCDSB students
- Eligible applicants must commit to participating in the YSP for the entire week of chosen program
- Must currently be in grade 10, 11 or 12
- Demonstrated financial need
- Eligible applicants must have demonstrated academic excellence.

Disclaimer: If the scholarship applicant has registered for a YSP module already the applicant will no longer be eligible for the YSP scholarship.

Scholarship recipients will be contacted by mid-June.
