INSTRUCTIONS

Every summer, high school students are offered a unique law school experience by the University of Toronto's Faculty of Law. During the Law YSP, students currently enrolled in grades 10 through 12 can spend between one and four weeks at the Faculty of Law discussing advanced legal concepts, learning about the reality of the Canadian legal system, and applying their knowledge in a variety of stimulating environments. For the summer of 2024 the program will be delivered in-person at the University of Toronto Faculty of Law. Scholarships are offered on the merit of each student's application and demonstrated financial need. All scholarships cover the full cost of the program for **one of the seven modules**. Travel, accommodation, and meals are not included.

Your supporting letter must confirm the following:

- Your interest in the program & financial need (where possible)
- Why you should be considered for a scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to full time high school students
- Must self-identify as Indigenous (First Nations, Metis or Inuit)
- Must commit to participating in the YSP for the entire duration of the week
- Must currently be in grade 10, 11 or 12
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated academic excellence.

Disclaimer: If the scholarship applicant has already registered for a YSP module the applicant will no longer be eligible for the YSP scholarship.
