

2024 LAW Youth Summer Program (YSP) FACULTY OF LAW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR BLACK STUDENTS

INSTRUCTIONS

Every summer, high school students are offered a unique law school experience by the University of Toronto's Faculty of Law. During the Law YSP, students currently enrolled in grades 10 through 12 can spend between one and four weeks at the Faculty of Law discussing advanced legal concepts, learning about the reality of the Canadian legal system, and applying their knowledge in a variety of stimulating environments. For the summer of 2024 the program will be delivered in-person at the University of Toronto Faculty of Law.

The Law Youth Summer Program aims to support high school students with an interest in exploring the legal profession and the legal field in the areas of criminal law, corporate law, international law and social justice. Scholarships are offered on the merit of each student's application and their demonstrated financial need. All scholarships cover the full cost of the program for **one of the seven modules**.

Your supporting letter must confirm the following:

- Your interest in the program & financial need (where possible); and
- Why you should be considered for the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to full time high school students who identify as Black enrolled in a Canadian high school
- Eligible applicants must commit to participating in the YSP for the entire week of the program
- Must currently be in grade 10, 11 or 12
- Demonstrated financial need
- Eligible applicants must have demonstrated academic excellence.

Disclaimer: If the scholarship applicant has already registered for a YSP module the applicant will no longer be eligible for the YSP scholarship.

Scholarship recipients will be contacted no later than June 1, 2024.
