The Temerty Faculty of Medicine's Youth Summer (Med YSP) at University of Toronto gives students an opportunity to experience day-to-day life of a university student through a highly structured, intensive week of labs, lectures and discussions. Students will attend the program in-person at the St. George Campus (downtown Toronto). The Toronto Catholic District School Board (TCDSB) in partnership with Med YSP is offering a scholarship to attend the program in Summer 2025.

INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarships are offered on the merit of your application and demonstrated financial need. All scholarships cover the full cost of the program for any one of the four modules (Human Physiology, Molecular Biology & Genetics, Pharmacology & Toxicology, and Microbiology).

Eligibility Requirements:

- Completed Grade 9, 10, 11, or 12, by June 2025.
 - Grade 9 students can only participate in Module 2: Microbiology.
- Open to TCDSB students only.
- Demonstrated financial need.
- Good academic record.

If the scholarship applicant has registered for a regular YSP module or is taking another summer school program, the applicant will no longer be eligible for the YSP scholarship.


